**We are seeking to fill more than 50 new mentor slots for the 2019-2020 school year - we need you!**

United Way's Middle School Mentoring Program is aimed at pairing nurturing adults as positive mentors one-on-one with 6th, 7th and 8th grade students for one hour a week during the lunch period at school. Partner schools are located in both Pueblo City Schools and Pueblo School District 70.

<b><u>When:</u></b>	Program Runs from Fall 2019 - End of the School Year
<b><u>How:</u></b>	Mentors are asked to spend just <u>1 hour per week</u> with their student during the lunch hour through the duration of the program
<b><u>Students:</u></b>	Male and female - 6th, 7th, & 8th grade students
<b><u>Mentors:</u></b>	Employees that are available 1 hour/week during lunch so that they can mentor students. Having time, being committed and attentive during the time with the student is crucial. A second key quality that mentors have to possess is dependability. Safety screening, references, interview and training required for all potential mentors.

**Safety screening required for all potential mentors:**

- Criminal History & Child Abuse Registry Review
- Personal Interview
- References
- Training

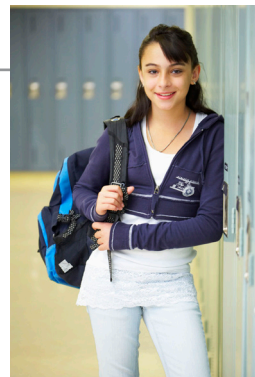
